Day 1: Arrive Auckland

Arrival transfer to hotel or collect rental car for self drive option.

Day 2: Auckland – Waitomo –Rotorua

Travel south of Auckland to Rotorua via the famous Waitomo Caves. This tour enables you to visit the Waitomo Glowworm Caves World renowned and a magnet for both local and overseas visitors, the Waitomo Glowworm Caves occupy a high placing in almost everyones New Zealand vacation wish-list. The Waitomo glowworm, *Arachnocampa luminosa*, is unique to New Zealand. Thousands of these tiny creatures radiate their unmistakable luminescent light as our expert guides provide informative commentary on the Caves' historical and geological significance.

Day 3: Rotorua Sightseeing

Experience Te Puia, a place of Maori culture and a thermal wonderland of impressive geysers and boiling mud pools. Explore Trout Springs Nature Park, which showcases native flora and fauna as well as the New Zealand Kiwi. Then see NZ's agricultural industry in action with a sheep shearing display and sheep dog trials at the Farm Show.

Day 4: Rotorua – Wellington

Today you will travel alongside Lake Taupo and across the Volcanic Plateau with stunning views of Mt Ruapehu before arriving at Wellington, New Zealand's capital city.

Day 5: Wellington to Christchurch

This morning you will be transferred to ferry terminal & connect the Ferry from Wellington to Picton. & board on coachtravel along the coast to Christchurch

Day 6: Christchurch to Fox Glacier

The TranzAlpine –Christchurch to Greymouth, rated one of the world's great scenic railway journeys! From your carriage you'll see the fields of the Canterbury Plains and farmland, followed by the spectacular gorges and river valleys of the Waimakariri River. Your train then climbs into the Southern Alps before descending through lush beech rain forest to the West Coast town of Greymouth – a great base for visits to Punakaiki and the always popular glaciers. South West New Zealand World Heritage Area huge rivers of ice, living remnants of the ice ages, carve a spectacular landscape from the snowfields of the Southern Alps to their terminal faces near sea level. Get up close and hear the glaciers creaking and cracking as they constantly grind down the valleys. Near Fox Glacier is Lake Matheson, formed some 14,000 years ago from a huge sheet of trapped ice.

Day 7: Fox Glacier to Queenstown

This morning you will continue your journey south along the West Coast before again crossing the Southern Alps over the Haast Pass and arriving in Queenstown

Day 8: Queenstown

Today is a free day for you to join some optional tours. Like LOTR Tours, Jet boat, white water rafting, The Earnslaw steamer cruises, etc.

Day 9: Queenstown – Milford Sound – Te Anau

Milford Sound is simply stunning. It is a natural wonder of world fame. In Maori legend, the fiords were created not by rivers of ice, but by Tu Te Raki Whanoa, a godly figure who came wielding a magical adze and uttering incantations. Milford Sound (Piopiotahi) is without doubt his finest sculpture. Whatever the fiord's mood - teeming with rain or with sun glistening on deep water - it will inspire you. Nowhere else in Fiordland do the mountains stand as tall, straight out of the sea. In the foreground of the fiord stands the legendary Mitre Peak, a remarkable presence dominating the skyline. *Self drive – cruise only.*

Day 10: Te Anau – Dunedin

This morning you will drive/coach to Dunedin in time to explore this 'Scottish' city or visit the wildlife on Otago Peninsula

Day 11: Dunedin to Christchurch

Today you will travel up North into The Waitaki district is a place of haunting natural beauty, complemented by Oamaru's historic whitestone architecture. In the two cities of the region, Christchurch and Timaru, great care has been taken to preserve Canterbury's colonial heritage. Grand architecture, historic homesteads and immaculate parks intermingle with the technology and style of modern life. Then come to Canterbury plains then to Christchurch.

Day 12: Depart Christchurch

Transfer you to the airport or return your rental car at airport.
